"Continuous Improvement Through Education"

EPA's new Lead Renovation, Repair and Painting (RRP) rule took effect April 22, 2010. All contractors performing activities that disturb more than six square feet of surface area in homes, child care facilities, schools or other public and commercial facilities built before 1978 must be certified and must follow specific work practices to prevent lead contamination. At a minimum, supervisors must be certified and trained. The Rocky Mountain Center for Occupational and Environmental Health has been approved by the State of Utah and EPA to provide the initial course. The refresher course has been approved by the State of Utah; EPA approval is pending.

COURSES OVERVIEW

These courses are intended to meet requirements established by EPA and other regulatory agencies for those involved in lead renovation, repair and painting activities. The audience includes renovators, remodelers, painters, maintenance personnel, and any other workers removing or modifying painted surfaces. The training will not only enhance credentials as private contractors but will also satisfy HUD requirements for interim controls training in Federally-assisted housing.

CREDIT

The Lead Renovation, Repair, and Painting (RRP) Course will be awarded Continuing Education Units (CEU's), the national standard of recognition for non-university professional education. ABIH CM points have been requested.

The initial training course has been approved by the Utah Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing (DOPL) for 8 core credit hours.

The refresher course has been approved for 4 credit hours.

Fee for credits and processing is \$15.

COURSE CONTENT

8-HOUR INITIAL COURSE

The Lead RRP eight hour class covers topics such as tenant notification, conducting lead paint surveys, proper work practices, clean-up, record-keeping and on-the-job training. There is also a 2 hour hands-on component. These exercises allow participants to practice the knowledge and skills that they have gained in the classroom in a realistic setting. The regulation is currently only applicable to pre-1978 housing that is occupied by children under the age of six or a pregnant woman but the EPA is considering making it applicable to any building constructed prior to 1978 which is when lead paint was banned.

4-HOUR REFRESHER COURSE

The Lead RRP 4-hour refresher course is required to keep your certification up to date. In this course we will review, regulations, using EPA recognized test kits, best setup practices, personal protective equipment and dust control, cleaning and checking your work, recordkeeping and training the non-certified renovators. Please note that if you have previous completed RRP lead paint training, you may qualify to take the refresher for certification; however, you must provide previous certification before enrolling. NOTE: You must take the refresher before the expiration date or you must retake the initial course..

ONSITE TRAINING

Need a course for your facility? If you have 13 or more people, onsite training courses can be arranged.
