Gary Spangenberg: The State has proposed a number of changes to the guidelines for the upcoming new year July, 01, 2015 to June 30, 2016. This meeting has been advertised in the Salt Lake City Tribune and Deseret Morning News statewide and also on the State of Utah Public Meeting website. A list of proposed changes has been sent to local agencies and there are copies of those changes here today. As of today, I have received no comments, either from agencies or from the public.

Nelson Yellowman South Eastern Association of Local Governments: I have had several clients ask to have their home re-weatherized. Can we request the re-weatherization date be changed? **Brad Carpenter's response:** 10 CFR 440, which is the regulation that governs the program, would need to be changed. As part of the ARRA stimulus in 2008-2009, the re-weatherization dates were changed from 1 October 1993 to 1 October 1994. In order to change those dates again, CFR 440 would need to be amended which needs approval from congress. We could raise that question with our DOE Program Officer.

Ian Spangenberg Manager Salt Lake Community Action Program Weatherization Program: SLCAP intends to submit a bid in response to the RFP that will be released for the Tri-County service area.
